Transport options

Horizons Regional Council will be running its bus service throughout the Horizons Region during Super Saturday.

In conjunction with Waka Kotahi NZTA, bus users can use Horizons bus services for free for travel to and from their Covid vaccination appointments until December 31 2021. This will be available in Palmerston and Levin. The free fare is accessed under a high trust model by showing the driver the text or email confirmation of an appointment, or vaccination card on the return trip.
